Licence for the use of the BIM reference model

Licensor:

(hereinafter: **BKZT**),

1. Preamble

The Building Information Modelling (BIM) reference model (hereinafter: model) is a high-level standard of a digital 3D building model for demonstration, research and training purposes, which was essentially created taking into account software-specific requirements.

By exercising the Licensed Rights (as defined below), you agree to be legally bound by the terms of this Licence. Insofar as these Licence Terms are to be regarded as a licence agreement, BKZT grants the Licensed Rights in return for your acceptance of the Licence Terms.

2. Object of use

As stated in the preamble, BKZT provides the model as an open-source file for download free of charge. The scope depends on the degree of completion of the work at the time of download.

3. Intellectual Property Rights / Copyright

The copyright to the model lies with the author. However, BKZT has a comprehensive right to use the model. All rights to the model remain with BKZT.

4. Granting of licence

BKZT grants you the non-exclusive right to use the Building Information Modelling (BIM) reference model exclusively for the following purposes, for an unlimited period of time and territorially unrestricted:

The model may only be used, reproduced, and passed on for demonstration, research and training purposes.

Editing of the model prior to reproduction or distribution (in particular by providers of common architecture and planning software) is only permitted for demonstration, research and training purposes. In this case, editing is only permitted in the context of model extensions (e.g., integral planning or variant planning, viewer model, building services model, reinforcement planning), but not in the form of changes to the architecture or basic structure of the work.

BKZT acquires the exclusive, temporally, territorially and content-wise unrestricted right to use any future model extensions in the above sense and reserves the right to make the model with the acquired model extensions available as an open-source file under the same licence conditions for demonstration, research and training purposes.

The model may not be reproduced, redistributed, or used or modified in any way not expressly stated in this licence.

5. Licence conditions

The exercise of the rights granted under point 4. is expressly subject to the following conditions:

Attribution and copyright notice

The licence transfer must be clearly indicated to the user in the context of each transfer of the model, naming the author and BKZT (e.g., © Arch. DI Siegfried Diesenberger/Bundeskammer der Ziviltechniker:innen) must be clearly recognisable.

Reference in an appropriate place to the present licence conditions, stating the following disclaimer:

"The BIM reference model of the Federal Chamber of Architects and Chartered Engineering Consultants is made available to the general public under certain conditions exclusively for demonstration purposes and as a training and research document. The Federal Chamber and Arch. DI Siegfried Diesenberger do not assume any warranty regarding the functionality or suitability of the BIM reference model for a specific purpose. The Federal Chamber and Arch. DI Siegfried Diesenberger are not liable for any damage caused by the use of the model. In particular, the Federal Chamber and Arch. DI Siegfried Diesenberger accept no liability for planning services carried out using the model. In the event of improper use of the model provided, the user shall indemnify and hold the Federal Chamber and Arch. DI Siegfried Diesenberger harmless against third parties.

The model may not be reproduced, redistributed or used or modified in any other way that is not expressly stipulated in the licence conditions"

 Hyperlink or URL to the work and an indication (e.g., in a modification file) of whether and how the work has been modified.

The modified model must therefore be distributed under the same licence conditions. No additional or different conditions may be offered, or technical measures applied if this restricts the exercise of the rights to the adapted work.

6. Remuneration

The exercise of the licenced rights granted in point 4. is free of charge.

In the event of any other use, BKZT expressly reserves the right to demand appropriate remuneration, in particular if the model is used for purposes contrary to the contract.

7. Term and termination

The licence is valid until the expiry of the copyright protection period. Your rights under this licence expire automatically if the conditions for granting the licence are no longer met or if the conditions of this licence are not complied with.

BKZT reserves the right to offer the model under other conditions or to discontinue the distribution of the model at any time; this does not invalidate this licence.

The contract can be cancelled in writing at the end of each month subject to a notice period of 6 months.

8. Warranty/liability

The model is made available exclusively for demonstration, research and training purposes to the extent available at the time of download, whereby BKZT and the author do not assume any warranty with regard to functionality or suitability for a specific purpose. BKZT and the author shall not be liable for any damages resulting from the use of the model. In particular, BKZT and the author accept no liability for planning services carried out using the model.

In the event of improper use of the model provided, you shall indemnify and hold harmless BKZT and the author against third parties.

9. Final provisions

Amendments and supplements to this agreement must be made in writing. Should any provision of this agreement be or become invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions shall remain unaffected. The contracting parties undertake to replace ineffective

provisions immediately with new effective provisions that come as close as possible to the original purpose of the contract.

10. Place of jurisdiction / applicable law

All disputes arising out of or in connection with this licence shall be settled exclusively by the competent court for A-1010 Vienna, depending on the amount in dispute.

This licence shall be governed exclusively by Austrian substantive law to the exclusion of the conflict of laws rules of Austrian private international law and to the exclusion of the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods.
